- Students are generally satisfied with the availability of classrooms (79.2%), security (73.4%), and the Student Redressal Committee (77.1%).
- Areas needing improvement include library resources (quantity and quality of books) and toilet hygiene.
- Feedback on teachers is positive, with high marks for punctuality (average above 88%) and explaining course content (average above 86%).

Detailed Analysis:

Facilities and Infrastructure:

- A good number of students (70.5%) find the number of classrooms adequate.
- The canteen facility received mixed reviews, with a slight majority (59.7%) finding it satisfactory.
- The cleanliness and maintenance of the campus (74.8%) and labs (77.1%) received positive feedback.

Library:

• While the seating capacity (73.4%) and working hours (73.4%) of the library seem satisfactory, the availability (quantity and quality) of books needs improvement.

- Encouraging class participation received slightly lower marks, with an average across subjects ranging from 78.2% to 82.1%.
- The use of modern teaching aids received an average across subjects ranging from 68.2% to 73.4%.
- Across subjects, an average of 78.6% of students felt teachers completed the syllabus on time.
- Faculty availability for students outside of class received an average across subjects ranging from 86.3% to 89.8%.

Laboratories:

- While a significant portion (around 50%) found lab equipment in working condition, improvement is needed.
- Cleanliness and labeling of equipment received positive feedback (around 78%).
- Opportunities for students to perform experiments themselves (around 50%) and using lab hours effectively for experiments (around 52%) need improvement.
- Feedback on lab teachers' knowledge and ability to conduct experiments smoothly was positive (around 78% and 80% respectively).

Recommendations:

- Invest in improving the quantity and quality of books in the library.
- Improve hygiene and cleanliness in toilets.
- Encourage teachers to incorporate more interactive activities and utilize modern teaching aids effectively.
- Ensure all lab equipment is functional and properly labeled.
- Provide more opportunities for students to conduct experiments independently.

Areas for Improvement

- While most teachers agree the syllabus can be covered in the allocated time (68.3% agree/strongly agree), some may require adjustments to ensure proper pacing. The college can explore solutions to address these concerns.
- While the library resources are generally well-regarded (73.2% agree/strongly agree), there may be a need to further expand the collection of reference materials, textbooks, and journals to fully support faculty needs.

- Similar sentiments exist regarding classrooms and laboratories (68.3% agree/strongly agree). While generally well-maintained, some improvements could be made to enhance the learning environment.
- The data suggests potential shortcomings in ICT facilities and internet connectivity, with only 51.2% of teachers agreeing they are adequate. Upgrading these facilities could significantly improve teaching and learning experiences.
- Decentralized governance may require further clarification as opinions were more divided (36.6% agree/strongly agree). The college can organize discussions or information sessions to ensure a clear understanding of this concept and its implementation.


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



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
